### STAUNTON TRIPS

The cost of the trip is £8 which includes animal feed, drinks and sandwiches, lunch provided by the nursery and an ice-cream! Children are welcome to return to Nursery for the afternoon. #### Please label all uniform

Children will need sunhats in the hot weather. Please apply sun cream before children come to school on hot days.

#### **Wellington boots**

Children will still need wellies at nursery so they can enjoy making their mud pies in the mud kitchen this term.

**Crocs and flip flops** are not safe for the children in the playground. Please could children wear doodles or shoes so that they can safely climb and run.

The blue/white check summer dress for the girls is optional. Dresses can be purchased at Marks and Spencer, Tesco , Asda or Sainsbury's.

#### **Packed Lunches**

Part of our Early years and OFSTED requirements are to encourage healthy, balanced and nutritious meals. In September 2015 we added" no sweets, crisps or chocolate to our packed lunch policy. (The no nut and peanut butter policy remains due to some children being allergic to nuts)

The children talk so confidently now about healthy foods, treats and recycling and what to put in our compost bin. It has been so rewarding to see how much the children have learnt.

The first steps nutrition trust http://www.firststepsnutrition.org/ continues to provide information to support eating well from preconception to 5 years from experienced nutritionists. They have an amazing web site with many packed lunch ideas, portion sizes all at a low cost!

**Cooking** will take place on a variety of mornings and afternoons during the term.

#### **Library morning** will be on a Tuesday.

The activities will be changed again in September so the children can gain new experiences.
